This training includes basic understanding and applying relevant legislation and procedures to ensure compliance in workers' compensation applications and injury management processes. The course focuses on the early return to work principles, effective engagement of rehab providers, development of suitable duties programs, effective workplace communication, case and system review techniques and continuous improvement.

Both theoretical and practical scenarios are discussed in the course, building the prospective RRTWC's confidence in the process of managing claims, communicating effectively with relevant stakeholders, identifying suitable duties in the workplace, and effectively assisting the injured worker's rehabilitation needs and graduated return to work.
